Time:

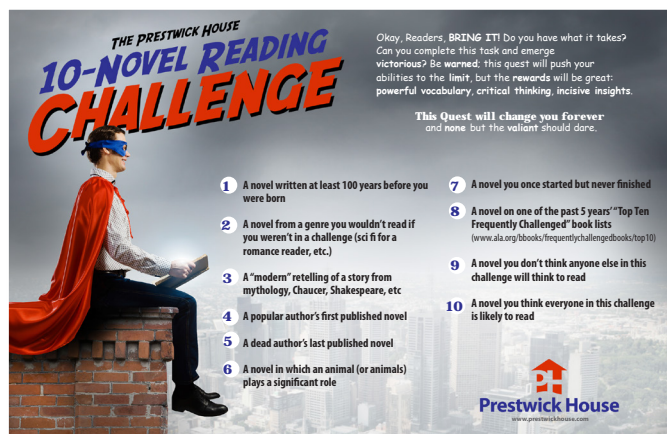
Independent reading through the end of the school year
